Based on the Four Means of Drawing Sentient Beings the training covers the topics of Giving; how we give as an organization and as individuals, Speaking Kind Words and the karma of speech, Teaching According to the Level of the Student and how to do this with the variety of teaching programs and materials we have available within the organization, and Practicing What You Teach which explores the Inner Job Description and being a role model of proper behavior. This is a full-time five day training program. The manual used with this program is *A Practical Guide of Skillful Means*.
